Uniform (Year 11 only)	Items which are not acceptable

Optional Items	Items which are not acceptable
A plain, narrow, black belt with a discreet buckle	Any other form of belt
Makeup, hair style and colour, nail varnish and piercings which are suitable for a workplace environment. Nails must be at a safe and practical length for all school activities (e.g. using a keyboard, playing a sport). All piercings must be removable and done so on staff request (e.g. for PE or dance).	No extreme or unsafe facial piercings.
A coat and scarf (which can be worn on the way to school and during break/lunch only)	Coats/scarfs are not to be worn inside the school building

PE/Performing Arts Kit

For PE:

Plain white socks
Plain red shorts/skort or black leggings
Plain white polo shirt
Trainers suitable for sport
Red round neck sweatshirts with school logo
Le Rocquier black zip top
Red socks with white trim
Football boots and shin pads
Gum shield

For Dance:

Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8 and 9): PE kit may be worn or black leggings and a white polo shirt.

Key Stage 4 (Year 10 and 11): Black leggings and a white polo shirt or black Performing Arts polo shirt.

Outside activities (such as outdoor learning, Princes Trust etc.)

Appropriate clothing should be worn for these activities (as directed by the group leader).

Uniform should be worn before and after the event, students will be given time to change in school.

Equipment

All students must have a **backpack/rucksack and pencil case** with the following items inside:

Black/blue pens (x2 minimum)
Pencil
Rubber
Ruler
Sharpener
Scientific Maths Calculator
Protractor
Compass
Highlighter
Another colour pen (e.g., red, green, purple etc)
Coloured pencils

Business Dress (Year 11 by invite only)

Year 11 students who are part of the SSLT are invited as part of this role to wear business style clothing as outlined below (suitable for an office environment):-

- A plain dark suit (jacket must be worn), colours may be black, navy or dark grey
- A shirt or blouse which must have a collar.
- A tie of their choice (girls are not required to wear a tie)
- A school badge on their lapel recognising their status (gifted by the school and replaceable for £2.00) • Black smart school shoes.

Note: Girls should pay particular attention to ensuring that midriffs etc... are covered. Trousers should be full length, should not be low waisted and shirts/blouses should cover the waistband. Skirt length must as a minimum reach the top of the knee.

Any student who arrives at school inappropriately dressed may be sent home, persistent offenders will have the privilege of wearing the Year 11 Business dress removed and be expected to return to normal school uniform.
