Year 11 will wear the full Le Rocquier School Uniform including a blazer.

Uniform Year 11	Items which are not acceptable.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Le Rocquier School Blazer • Le Rocquier School Tie in black (available from the main school office to purchase for £5) • Plain white shirt with a collar OR Le Rocquier blouse • Plain black trousers • Black Charleston Skirt which must sit no more than 1 inch above the knee (available from JSSK or Lyndale Sports) • Plain black tights or ankle socks OR White knee length socks • Plain black shoes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any other blazer/hoody/jumper/jacket • An unbuttoned shirt A visible t-shirt An exposed midriff • Jeans of any style Tracksuit bottoms/jogging bottoms of any variety Trousers that are: frayed, clingy, made of Lycra, decorated. • A short or tight skirt Skirts with splits in the seams No lycra • Patterned tights Coloured/patterned socks • High heels/stilettoes or Boots • No logos/designs/patterns or colours on the shoes

Business Dress

Year 11 students who are part of the SSLT are invited as part of this role to wear business style clothing as outlined below:-

- A plain dark suit (jacket must be worn), colours may be black, navy or dark grey
- A shirt or blouse which must have a collar.
- A tie of their choice (girls are not required to wear a tie)
- A school badge on their lapel recognising their status (gifted by the school and replaceable for £2.00)
- Black smart school shoes.

Note: Girls should pay particular attention to ensuring that midriffs etc... are covered.

Trousers should be full length, should not be low waisted and shirts/blouses should cover the waistband. Skirt length must as a minimum reach the top of the knee.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A plain, narrow, black belt with a discrete buckle • Subtle, unobtrusive makeup and clear nail varnish • Natural hair colours only • One pair of ear studs. One watch • A coat and scarf (which can be worn on the way to school and during break/lunch only) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Skirts made of stretchy material and or shorter than the top of the knee • No shorts • No Jeans, leggings or jegging's • No T-shirt or patterned jumpers • No dresses • No "skinny" style trousers • No trousers above the ankle • No brightly coloured shoes • No coloured nail varnish • No more than 1 pair of earrings

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No stretchers• No facial piercings• No heavy make-up inc false eyelashes• No patterned tights or coloured socks• No shirts / blouses without a collar
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Any student who arrives at school inappropriately dressed may be sent home, persistent offenders will have the privilege of wearing the Year 11 Business dress removed and be expected to return to normal school uniform.
