Exam Results Day – Thursday 12th August 2021

Due to social distancing, we have had to slightly adjust the way exam results are picked up on Thursday 12th August 2021. We will be inviting students to pick up their results in their form groups within these allotted times:

09.00am Fauvic House
09.15am Icho House
09.30am Keppel House
09.45am Le Hocq House
10.00am Le Hurel House
10.15am Platte Rocque
10.30am Seymour House

Senior Staff from school will be available during these times should you have any questions regarding the results you receive and guidance on next steps. There will also be staff in school on Friday 13th August between 9am-1pm should you need any assistance. We are aware that the Colleges, Highlands and Hautlieu are contacting students separately about how to respond to course offers on results day. If you have any questions regarding your Post 16 course, please contact them directly.

If a student is isolating or is away on results day, you can either:

Ask a responsible person to pick up the results providing we have a communication from the student stating they give their permission and name the person who will be collecting the results. This should be an e-mail to exams@lrs.sch.je The collector will need to bring with them photographic ID (Passport, driving licence etc.)

Or

The learner provides the school with an addressed envelope and we will post it to them. Please be aware that your results will arrive in the post, up to a few days after results day.

The exam results that have been award are not allowed to be shared prior to results day. However, JCQ have requested that we inform you of the following:

The evidence to award a qualification grade has used a range of sources. These will vary depending upon the qualification requirements. The evidence may include, where applicable: mock exams results, coursework, classwork if appropriate, assessments, performances, practical pieces, any prior external exams already undertaken during a qualification, and any suitable evidence that supports the grade awarded. An holistic approach to the evidence has been taken into account when awarding a grade. Learners are already aware of their current performance from school reports and feedback from teachers that have been shared throughout the qualification.

Any learner that has previously been allocated special circumstances such as access arrangements and mitigating circumstances have had these taken into consideration.

Key dates for non-priority appeals

From result day to 3 September 2021: Window for students to request a centre review.

From result day to 10 September 2021: Centres conduct centre reviews.

From result day to 17 September 2021: Centres submit appeals to awarding organisations.

If you would like to appeal a grade, we therefore need the completed appeals form (on our school web site) no later than 3rd September 2021. Ideally you will come to school on results day, or the day after to discuss you grades and evidence used before submitting the form.

Please ensure you have returned any textbooks that are still outstanding. Those who have books still in their possession will have received an invoice. **On exam results day please either bring back your textbooks or a cheque to cover the cost of replacing any lost books.**
